## MESSAGE FROM THE RABBIS

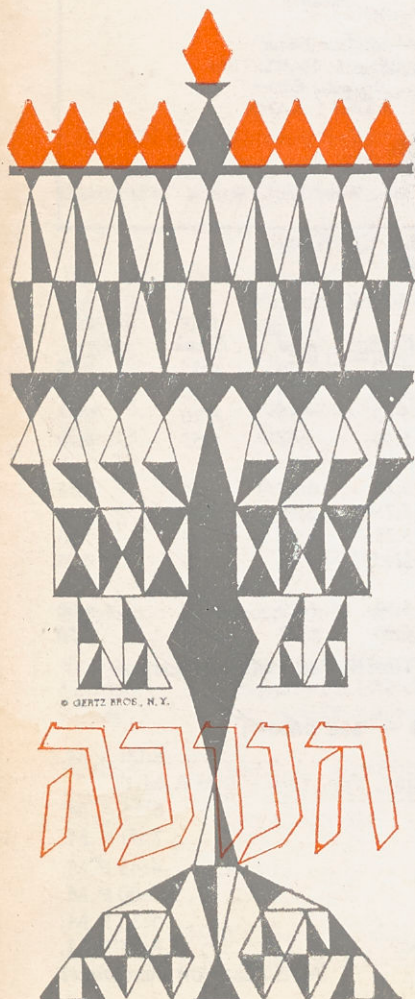
In the Jewish calendar, Chanukah and Purim are viewed as twins that have common elements in their observance and message. Both holidays happened after the Pentateuchal period, and both are identified with the Al Ha-Nissim prayer concerning the miracles that brought them about. Yet on Chanukah we recite Hallel, but not on Purim, because the Chanukah story took place in the land of Israel while Purim occurred in Persia, in *Galut* (Exile).

Both holidays are bound firmly with a message of religious freedom and natural survival. Both underscore spiritual loyalty and love of the Creator as an everlasting blessing on all who observe them.

As we light the candles each night, let there be illuminated in our hearts and homes the hopes and aspirations of our people for peace.

A happy Chanukah to each of you from our hearts and homes!
