



ELECTION WOES - ELECTION GLORY

What goes through the minds of the candidates? Phrases from the High Holiday liturgy: 'who will win - who will lose; who will endure --- whose tenure will end abruptly; who will be seared by the fire of scandal mongers -- who will be drowned in the flood of ill will.'

What is voters' dilemma? Torments and frustration: 'Who can lead - who will mislead; who is sincere -- who is fraudulent; who inspires confidence -- who shows weakness.'

In America and in Israel election fever rages, stimulating rhetoric, heightening tensions, stoking the furnaces of gossippers and lovers of titillating sensationalism. Issues and men are the issue, capabilities and views. Economy and education, crime and foreign policy here -- absorption if immigrants and peace talks, land and security, social fabric and culture there. Democracy at work, government by the people.

Its roots (so we are taught) reach back to Athenian and Roman legacies. In the beginning it was pure democracy, the direct participation of all the people, but proliferating populations necessitated election of representative institutions. A development, not ideal and often deplorable -- as witnessed by the poor record of many an office holder -- but hardly avoidable.

Oh! for a clarity of decisions! Oh! for unanimity rather than a majority or plurality! Oh! for the clear, unequivocal mandate by an entire nation, rather than the insanity of current practice!

Precisely such a consummate, extraordinary, indeed utopian event was the Sinai experience, celebrated on Shavuot. It occurred over 33 centuries ago. An entire people assembled, summoned by the Almighty. To the hushed myriads, an offer:

"He (Moses) took the book of the covenant
and he read it for the people to hear;"

and there came a thunderous response:

"they said:

All that G'd has said

we will do and we will obey!"

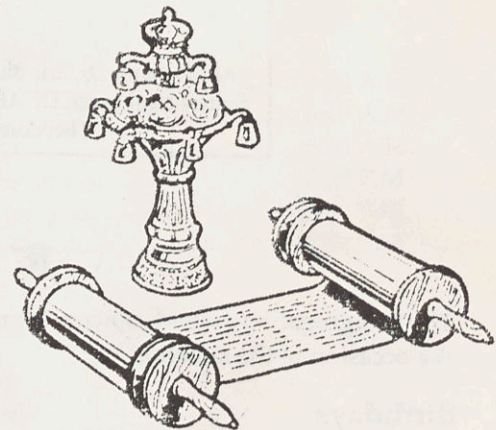
The sublime unanimity of an entire nation, with not a single dissenting vote. Truly 'democracy' (Greek demos = people; kratos = strength) "the strength of the people."
