Ramaz Academy Launches Defense Campaign

Ramaz Academy has seriously started to work for defense. Defense stamps are sold every Tuesday and Thursday morning. Books and magazines have started to come in for the Army and Navy. Then, too, tin foil, silver leaf, wire, etc. are being collected in each classroom. A plan for knitting squares for afghans is being organized. One or two of the mothers will be at the school one day a week in order to instruct, collect finished articles and distribute wool for additional work.
