RABBI HASKEL LOOKSTEIN ADDRESSES SISTERHOOD LUNCHEON MEETING

Some 60 members and friends of the Sisterhood attended the second open meeting of the year last Monday in the Synagogue Social Hall. The "guest" speaker for the occasion was Rabbi Haskel Lookstein who addressed the group for the first time.

Rabbi Lookstein, discussing "Judaism for the Modern Women", pointed out that his own title was a misnomer. Judaism, he said, is the same for men and for women, for ancient and for moderns.

Our speaker then explained that Judaism has always required its adherents to learn and to study, to teach by example, to perform the Commandments, faithfully, and thereby to preserve our religion and heritage.

The meeting was also an occasion for introducing new members into the Sisterhood. The members were welcomed into the group by Mrs. Meyer Texon, president.
