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'BOOK OF THE MONTH CLUB' LAUNCHED

The Am Hasefer (People of the Book) Program of the Kehilath Jeshurun Adult Institute was officially launched on Monday and Tuesday evenings January 11th and 12th.

The program, which might best be described as a modified Book of the Month Club began with two separate groups discussing Herman Wouk's "This Is My God."

Both groups heartily applauded Wouk's treatment of Judaism in concise and penetrating fashion. They discussed the author's style and purpose. They explored his rational and emotional explanation of Jewish symbols, customs, and laws. They offered critical opinions concerning his analysis of Divine Revelation.

All the members felt that the book was well worth reading and that the discussion had increased the dimensions of their understanding of the book in particular and of Judaism in general.

Next Meeting

At present the members are preparing for their second sessions. Group I is reading "Eva" by Meyer Levin in preparation for a discussion on Monday evening February 29th. Group II is reading Isidore Epstein's "Faith of Judaism" which will be discussed on Tuesday, February 23rd.

We hope the program will continue to stimulate and promote the reading of books of Jewish interest by our members.

PARENTS AND JUNIOR CONGREGATION

We are anxious to draw the attention of parents to the Junior Congregation which meets every Saturday morning at 10:15 in the synagogue chapel. The Junior Congregation serves the needs of children under 13.

We have discovered recently that a number of parents who come regularly to services keep their children with them in the main synagogue. While there are certainly exceptions to the rule, this practice is ill advised for children.

Many children cannot maintain attentiveness through a long adult service. Although they may sit quietly without disturbing those around them, this does not indicate interest on their part.

If a child is to learn how to pray well and to derive satisfaction from prayer he needs a service geared to his own level. In Junior Congregation many of the prayers are recited and sung aloud. In this way the child learns the words well and the melodies properly.

Of course at a junior service, the children serve as cantors and ushers. They receive Torah honors and announce pages.

This educational opportunity is offered by the synagogue every week. Parents are urged to take advantage of it.
