Every Wednesday evening, beginning with April 27th, the Talmud Class will continue its study of the Tractate "Beizah", dealing with the laws of Yom Tov. If you were unable to attend during the winter session, now is a good time to resume because the class is beginning to study new subject material.

The class is conducted in English and, like the Sabbath Class, is under the instruction of Rabbi Haskel Lookstein.
