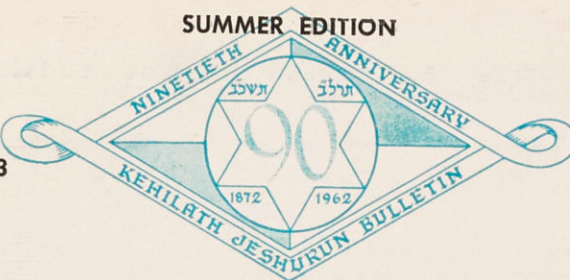

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More Than 100 Members Participate In Jewry Duty

This year again, the Jewry Duty Program broke all previous records for the participation of the members of our congregational family in the Daily Services. One hundred and sixteen men obligated themselves to attend, at least, one full week of morning services during the past year. This is the highest figure which we have ever reached and it indicates the increasing awareness on the part of our members, of the importance of the institution of daily worship.

Several of the participants whose names are listed in the honor roll in this issue of the bulletin, are regular members of the morning Minyan and come every morning. Others are involved in a new program which we have unofficially called the "Jewry Corps". Membership in this program obligates the participant to attend one day a week. Some of the men have been coming throughout the year on their particular day.

As a result of the wholehearted participation of our membership in the total Jewry Duty Program we are happy to say that our daily Minyan is functioning on a sound basis. In addition, many members of our congregation have become introduced to the practice of regular daily worship as a result of their participation in this program.

We hope that next year every member will feel it a personal obligation to join us in this great "Mitzvah". Together, we can insure the stability and the strength of the institution of daily worship which is the very foundation of an Orthodox synagogue.
