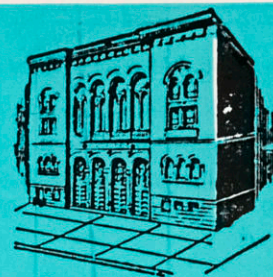

MAX J. ETRA, RE-ELECTED PRESIDENT AT ANNUAL MEETING Joseph Roth, Elgin Shulsky and Irwin Shapiro Re-elected To Office

The Assembly Hall of the Synagogue House, decorated in a festive fashion, was the scene of the Ninety-Sixth Annual Membership Meeting of the congregation, last Sunday morning. More than two hundred members were present, as the meeting was called to order by the President, Max J. Etra.

The membership, by unanimous vote, re-elected Max J. Etra, President. Re-elected with him were Joseph Roth, Vice President; Elgin Shulsky, Treasurer and Irwin Shapiro, Secretary. Following the singing of the National Anthem, led by Cantor A. Joseph Cohen, and the invocation pronounced by Rabbi Haskel Lookstein, Ira F. Weisman, Chairman of the Membership Committee, presented thirty-one new members for induction.

The President, on behalf of the entire membership, expressed the hope that the new members' affiliation will be a long and happy one.

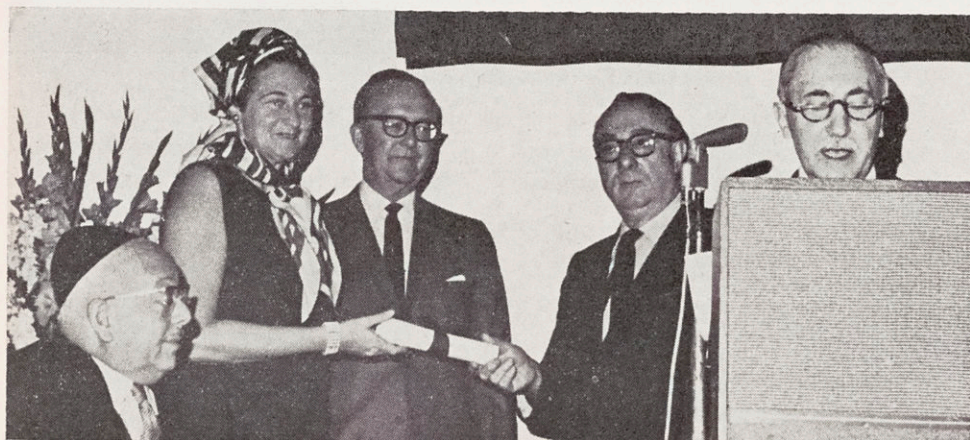

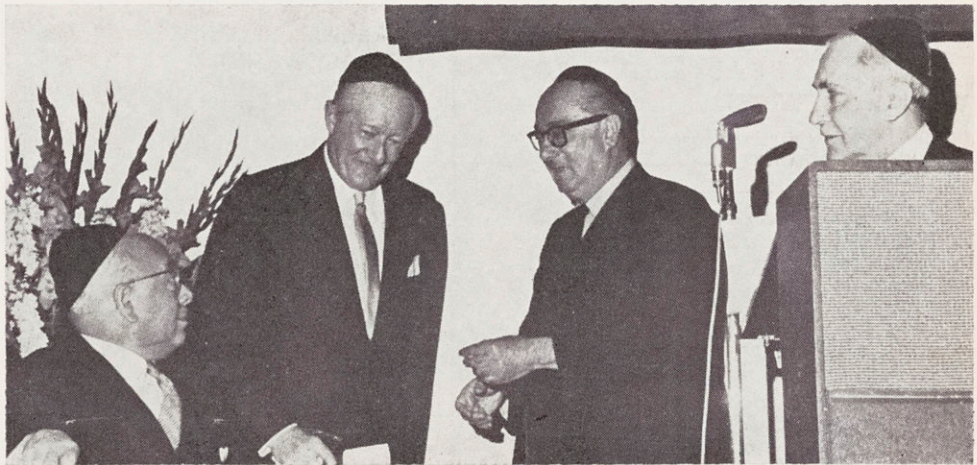
