Mr. and Mrs. Jess Ward Present Torah and Ark to the Congregation

We are proud and happy to announce that Mr. and Mrs. Jess Ward have presented as a gift to the congregation a beautiful Torah Scroll housed in a portable Ark. This gift is in memory of their respective parents: Isidor Freedman, Morris Ward and Rachel Ward.

The new Torah will be used whenever we have services and a Torah reading away from the synagogue premises. It will, of course, be an important addition to the observance of shiva in homes of members. We plan to use the Torah also at special services in the future which may take place on happy occasions in the homes of our members.

The Torah was used for the first time at a special service which was held on the second day of Shavuoth on East 67th Street, across the street from the Soviet Mission to the United Nations. On that occasion, twelve members of the congregation, led by Rabbi Haskel Lookstein, held a service at the request of the National Conference on Soviet Jewry, to protest the arrest and harassment of Jewish activists in Moscow and to call attention to the sharply reduced emigration of Jews from the Soviet Union during the past five months.

RAMAZ LEADS ALL YESHIVOT IN NEW YORK STATE AND NATIONAL ACADEMIC COMPETITION

The May issue of *The Principal*, published by the Board of Jewish Education, contains very gratifying news for all yeshivot in the metropolitan area. The Senior classes of those yeshivot have performed magnificently in the examinations administered for the New York State Scholarship and the National Merit Competition. Out of a total of 1,061 Seniors who took the New York State Scholarship Exam, 339 won scholarships, while 100 were alternates. There were also 20 finalists and 103 Letters of Commendation in the National Merit Competition.

We are very pleased to announce that Ramaz Seniors established the best record, percentage-wise, of all the yeshivot. 27 of 53 Seniors who took the State Scholarship Exam earned Scholarships, while 7 additional students were Alternates. Ramaz also had 3 Finalists and 14 Letters of Commendation in the National Merit Competition.

In addition, one Ramaz Senior won Honorable Mention in the Westinghouse Science Talent Search.

We all have reason to feel proud of this outstanding record established by all of the yeshivot. Understandably, we are very proud of the fact that this year Ramaz has the right to say: "We are number one."

Officers Institute New Policies in Congregation

During the first few weeks of the new administration in Kehilath Jeshurun, a number of new developments have occurred which we would like to bring to your attention.

Executive Committee Appointed

In order to widen the responsibilities of leadership in the congregation, Mr. Nathan Salzman, President, appointed two Trustees to serve with the Officers as an Executive Committee. The Trustees are Joseph Lorch, and Irwin Robins. More appointments may be made in the future.

A New Policy on Aliyot

The Executive Committee has decided to eliminate extra Aliyot on Shabbat morning, above and beyond the normal seven and one additional honor for Acharon. When a "simcha" occurs reasonable consideration will be exercised.

Such a policy will, of course, enhance immeasurably the reading of the Torah. It will make it possible for worshippers to follow the reading without unnecessary interruption. It will, however, necessitate forbearance and graciousness on the part of members who would like to be called to the Torah but who will have to forego that pleasure in the interests of giving honor to the Torah rather than being honored by it.

As examples of this spirit of "self sacrifice", the Rabbis recently forewent their usual Chazak Aliyah on a Sabbath when it was particularly difficult to accommodate all who by tradition were entitled to aliyyot. A number of other members also gave up their Aliyot that Sabbath.

Special Projects Committee Appointed

The President appointed a Special Projects Committee to coordinate the program of the Synagogue for the entire year. This Committee has already met several times and is in the process of drawing up a very interesting and comprehensive program for next year.
