After graduation from Cornell, Dr. Hoffmann interned at Mount Sinai Hospital. Following a period of general practice, he fitted himself for his specialty. During the course of his career, he has been affiliated with several New York Hospitals, and has supplemented his studies abroad.

A recognized authority in his field, Dr. Hoffmann has been a State expert in many major criminal cases. In 1929, he published an authoritative history of Medicine, entitled "Struggle for Health." The topic he has chosen for next Monday night gives promise of an unusually stimulating evening for all who attend.

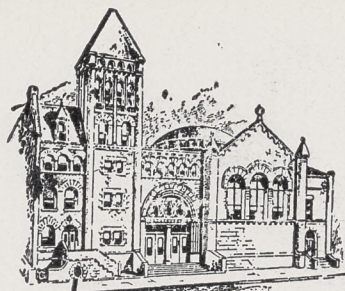

HEAD TOO LARGE

The Hitlerites have destroyed the statue of Woodrow Wilson at Posen because, they claim, it was an artistic eyesore, with the "head too large." Yes, indeed, Professor Wilson's head was too large for the peanut-sized Nazi "bean."

Every time a Nazi looked at the statue, he felt confronted by overwhelming moral principles, totally at variance with Nazi precepts. The stern symbol emphasized the moral isolation of the Germans and warned that they had embarked on a path that leads but to national disaster. As Wilson well said: "The man who knows the strength of the tide is the man who is swimming against it, not the man who is floating with it." The Nazis did not want to be reminded constantly of the overwhelming tide of world horror opposing them.

To the Nazis, the statue signified the American spirit, a dangerous force to be reckoned with, and depicted by Wilson at Philadelphia, the cradle of American liberty, on July 4, 1914:

"And my dream is this: that as the years go on and the world knows more and more of America, it will also drink at these fountains of youth and renewal, that it will also turn

to America for those moral inspirations that lie at the base of human freedom, that it will never fear America unless it finds itself engaged in some enterprise inconsistent with the rights of humanity, and that America will come into the full light of that day when all shall know she puts human rights above all other rights, and that her flag is the flag not only of America, but the flag of humanity."

Yes, the head was too large.

REALIZING YOUTHFUL AMBITIONS

We recall our youthful ambition to become a famous and hero-worshipped fireman. Dimly, we recollect our aspirations for the admiring plaudits of the crowd at our bravery in rescuing beauteous damsels from menacing conflagrations. It may seem strange, but in our early teens, we never thought anyone else worth rescuing. Others could burn to a crisp, for all we seemed to care.

Another great ambition of ours was based on the revenge motif. There were many people with whom we intended to square accounts some day---the teacher who sent our father a note which prompted a spanking, the janitor who misappropriated the great collection of packing cases we had laboriously assembled for election day bonfires (in those days we were non-partisan, celebrating the election and not the elected). Above all, our sweetest revenge was reserved for the corner cop who persistently raided our crap games when we had accumulated all our pals' tops, marbles and pennies, and confiscated our wealth.

As far as we are concerned, all these aspirations came to naught. For all we know, the teacher, the janitor, the corner cop, have reached a peaceful old age, untouched by Nemesis.

Not so for Russian statesmen. Like elephants, they never forget. We have just read that Vassili Borisok, a Czarist era corner cop, has been sentenced to ten years' imprisonment for having arrested Viacheslov M. Molotov, the present Soviet premier, when the latter was a mere student.

"Molly" old boy, you have liquidated your boyhood grudge. In true Gilbert and Sullivan-esque tradition, you may now sing, "Let the punishment fit the crime, tra la." The strange adventures of Alice in Wonderland must give way to the wierd capers of "Molly" in Sovietland.

CONSCIENCE

The sullyng of conscience, slowly but surely, undermines character. It is not necessary to break a mirror to pieces in order to make it worthless. Let one go behind it with a pencil and draw some lines through the silver coating and the mirror will be good for nothing. It is not necessary to deal it a hard blow to destroy its power; these delicate touches will do it, little by little. Like King Richard, one can say:

"My conscience hath a thousand
several tongues,

And every tongue brings in a
several tale

And every tale condemns me for
a villain."

In using the word "Conscience" we define the God force within us. In the same awareness which is within us to emphasize our wrong doing, there is another side which acts to illumine our welldoing. We recognize such a force in the words, "Virtue is its own reward." By this we affirm the fact that our worthwhile accomplishments need no recognition from the world. It is enough that God knows and through our conscience He gives us joy and pride in our creations, our work and our worthy deeds. Just as in physics, we have the law of the indestructibility of matter, so in the moral and spiritual realms we have the indestructibility of virtue. When we perform a good deed, its effect not only stays with us but finds its glow in the reward our children receive. Abraham prepared food and water for God's angels, so in turn does God send the manna and water for Abraham's children in the desert.

The contentment which we experience after completing some particularly praiseworthy task is as much a manifestation of God's judgment of what is good as the pangs of conscience are His condemnations of evil.

OUR BRETHREN THE WORLD OVER

Hitler's "Reservation:"

News comes thick and fast about Hitler's plan to transplant Jews from various parts of the Reich into the Lublin area of Poland. The work of resettling Jews from the Slovakian "protectorate," Austria, and most of Poland, we now hear, will be accomplished by Spring, 1940. It is even rumored that the sinister evacuation work has been started in Berlin.

The carrying out of the plan and the accompanying rumors have caused the utmost confusion among Jewish populations in affected areas. Jews are trying frantically to leave Vienna for foreign lands, and Jews from various parts of Poland are leaving for Lublin, in the hope that they will find better conditions there.

Inside Poland:

The atrocities in Poland continue, their chief form being the conscription of all classes of Jews for the most dangerous reconstruction work, which is made even more perilous by the brutal "pranks" of sadistic Nazi guards.

Tales of the tortures inflicted on Jews and Poles alike in the newly-established concentration camps, notably that at Wengrow, rival in horror the tales of misery at Dachau and other German concentration camps, as officially reported in the British White Paper of a few weeks ago.

Another Pogrom?

This is the question asked by anxious Jews throughout Germany, as, just one year after the ghastly outbreak following the assassination of Ernst Vom Rath, "Jews and British agents" are being vehemently blamed for the bombing that almost took Hitler's life in Munich last week. Unconfirmed reports reaching Paris speak of night raids in some German towns, in which Jewish homes are being raided and defaced. This time, the Jews, so recently dubbed Communists or international bankers, are branded as "British agents."

Persecution in Czechoslovakia:

A possible preparation for forcing all Czech Jews out of their employment is seen in a recent decree of Baron von Neurath, Reich administrator for Czechoslovakia. The decree invalidates indemnities for Jews dismissed from their jobs. Czech Jews, moreover, have been forbidden to live in houses owned by "Aryans."

Blessed Relief:

Soviet Russia, it is noted with relief, has not shown signs of adoption (Turn to page 6, col. 3)

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CLEAN POLITICS

(Extracts from address by
Mr. Robert P. Levis.)

Unless this nation devotes itself to Clean Politics, we're going to see the fall of this highly vaunted democracy. Europe has its various dictatorships because democracies failed to be honest and efficient; out of the resulting state of affairs have come the so-called "efficient" governments, which suppress the rights of individuals. Without Clean Politics, some kind of fascism will come here.

* * *

If we are to keep alive democracy and save this country from the fate of Europe, we must all take an active part in Politics. The matter with Politics at this time is simply the lethargy of the voters. At our last local elections, sixty per cent of the registered voters neglected to vote on a constitutional amendment that involved a moral issue. Forty per cent passed the measure; that is government by a minority. If this goes on--if the majority refuses to exercise its authority--I prophesy that we are on our way to ruin.

Another cause of dirty Politics is the existence of pressure groups, made up of individuals whose only interest in Politics is their own selfish advantage. To combat this evil, in addition to becoming aggressive politically, you must also act unselfishly. As Theodore Roosevelt has said, "The trick is not to beat the machine, but to **be** the machine," in other words, to use the power of organization for good and not evil ends. If Politics become the possession of selfish people, again I promise you that this democracy will fall.

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A VITAL ZIONIST BOOK

At a time when countries are being demolished and peoples ruthlessly destroyed, in an era when men, gathering not for the building of a better world, but rather with clinical thoroughness, are systematically undermining life and the opportunities for happiness, there appears this book entitled "REBUILDING PALESTINE". It is the first of its kind in an effort to present to our young people a sane, positive and wholesome way of living in a world that is bewildered by power politics and strife. It presents an example of how a people reconstructs and regenerates itself on its own soil after 1900 years of Galuth. It portrays an inspired, self-sacrificing yet humble people building a homeland through its own creative efforts and labor.

No matter how much one may know of his past, no matter how observant one may be of Jewish tradition, he cannot be a radiant, dynamic and fulfilled Jewish personality without intimately knowing the land for which Jewish hearts have yearned since the first exodus.

It is indeed with a great deal of pleasure that we read Dr. Edidin's book. It is abundant in rich detail, in facts that are transplanted in terms of human experience and human relationships. In simple and clear language, the author introduces us to the history of Palestine. He proceeds from the poetic and romantic hopes of a people in Galuth to the practical realization of its dream through deeds.

Not only does he describe the progress, since the war, in terms of health, education, industry and agriculture, but he gives a vivid picture of the country itself. We see the land in all its possibilities — the parts of Palestine both redeemed and unredeemed, a clear picture of life on the soil, a delineation of Zionist parties, the celebration of holidays, the Arab problem — all, all are related in the spirit of one who loves his people, his land and his traditions.

ing Nazi anti-Semitism. It is estimated that 14,000 Poles and Jews have found refuge in the new Western White Russia (former eastern Poland), and the new Reich-Soviet border has usually been open to refugees. Moreover, many who fled from eastern Poland into Hungary and Rumania during Hitler's "Blitzkrieg" are now returning hopefully to their homes.

In Wilno, recently ceded to Soviet-controlled Lithuania, responsible officials are pledging themselves to end the anti-Jewish outbreaks that followed the tremendous influx of refugees.

All, it would seem, is a bit quieter on the eastern front.

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
