### EXCERPTS FROM MRS. HERBERT S. GOLDSTEIN'S ISRAELI DIARY

During my recent visit to Israel, I came across an attractively bound volume called "Chronicles". Upon opening it I discovered that the format was that of a series of two-page news sheets. It contains news from the Bible presented in modern journalistic style, in clear and easily understood language. Anybody who is familiar with the Chumash will find it fascinating.

I was told that it was prepared in Jerusalem by scholars of Bible, Jewish history, archeology, and many other Jewish cultural fields,

and that it took five years of preparation. Originally one issue used to appear every month. In honor of Israel's tenth anniversary, the first twenty-six issues, covering the Biblical era from Abraham to Ezra, were bound. In this form, it first came to my attention. I was happy to learn that arrangements are now being made for its distribution in the United States and I am sure that those of you who will come upon it will enjoy "Chronicles" as much as
