FIRST SLICHOS, SATURDAY NIGHT SEPT. 22nd, 1:00 A.M.

Saturday night, September 22nd, we will show our earnest desire to repent and to return more fully to the faith, by giving up part of our sleeping hours and gathering instead in our Synagogue to say the "Slichos" prayer. "Slichos" is the plural of the Hebrew word "Selicho" which means forgiveness. As G-d fearing people, we are hesitant to approach our maker on the High Holy Days without having made prior preparations to repent. This is the essence of "Slichos."

"Slichos" will be said each morning thereafter before the "Shacharis" prayers until Yom Kippur. Among the prayers included in "Slichos" are "Sh-ma Kolenu", "Ashamnu" (the confession) and the "Yud Gimmel Middos" (the Thirteen Attributes).
