Director Jacob Goodman, a member of the class, will be the host at the Seuda.

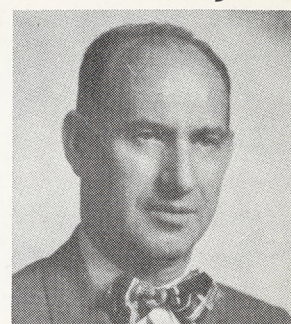
The entire congregation is invited to attend. Mincha will start at 2:45 P.M.

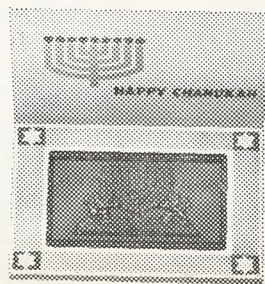
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
