### EXCERPTS FROM RABBI GOLDSTEIN'S PASSOVER SERMON

It is an unfortunate coincidence of history that at this time of Passover when we recall the attempt on the part of Pharaoh, the leader of Egyptians, to annihilate the Jewish people that we should be confronted today by a similar attempt on the part of Col. Nasser and his cohorts.

It is most distressing that hundreds of German scientists employed by Nasser should now have murderous intentions of destroying Israel, forgetting that the Nazis have murdered six million Jews.

Can the religious leaders of the world, as well as the Presidents of the Universities as well as their Professors representing our civilization today, be mute when such revelations about the German scientists have come to our attention.

President Kennedy I believe is a man of destiny and there is before him the great opportunity of bringing peace in the Middle East which is one of the promises he made before his election. I therefore suggest that President Kennedy call into conference Col. Nasser and Prime Minister Ben Gurion. We know that the Arabs have refused to sit down and talk peace, but I believe that neither Col. Nasser nor Prime Minister Ben Gurion would insult our President by refusing to accept an invitation from him. If the President really wants to seek peace in the Middle East, he must zealously pursue it.

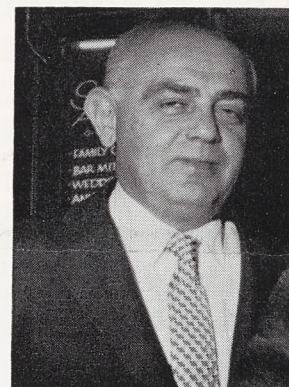
