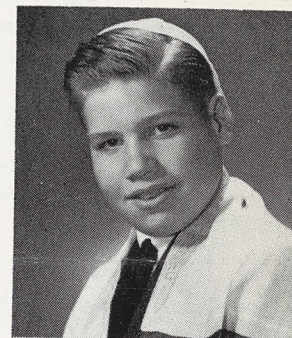
BASEBALL BENEFIT ON SUNDAY, JUNE 16th
