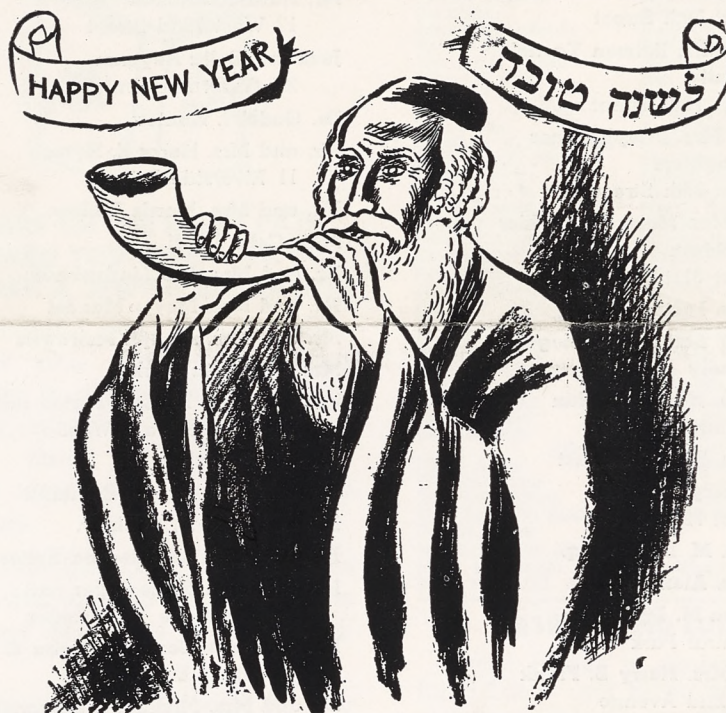

SWEETS FOR THE SWEET

Our Talmud Torah pupils, as well as all our youngsters, will assemble in front of the Synagogue the first day of Rosh Hashana, at 5:40 o'clock, and will proceed together to Central Park for the observance of Tashlich. Delicious sweets will be distributed with the compliments of the House of Gross.

Festival Notes

Rosh Hashana Eve —

As with every festival, Kiddush is recited over the wine and Shehecheyanu is added. On the second night, a new fruit which has not yet been eaten in its season is placed on the table for the Shehecheyanu of the Kiddush which embraces also the fruit.

It is customary to dip the Hamotzi in honey to denote a sweet year.

Tashlich —

Tashlich, a deeply symbolic tradition, takes place on the first day of Rosh Hashana when we go to a body of water and symbolically free ourselves of our sins.

Erev Yom Kippur —

The Erev Yom Kippur Mincha service precedes the final meal of that day. The "Al Chate" prayer of Yom Kippur is added to the Shmoneh Esray of Mincha (this Mincha service is found in the Yom Kippur Machzor). Successive Mincha services on Erev Yom Kippur are conducted at our Synagogue from 2:00 to 3:45 P.M.

Reminder: bring non-leather footwear for Yom Kippur.
