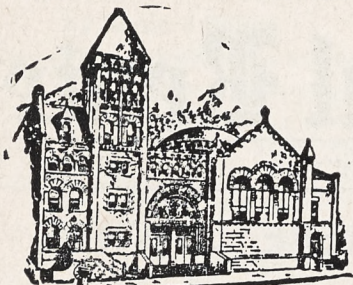

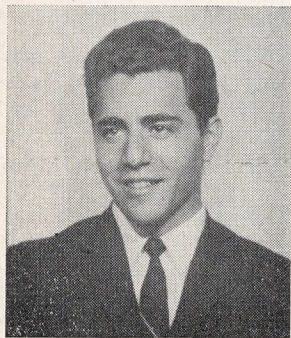
SUMMER CAMP IN ISRAEL

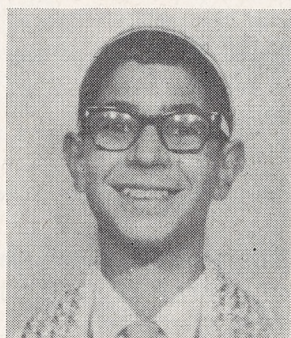

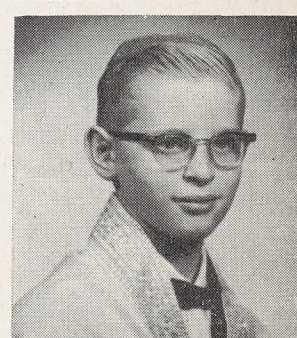

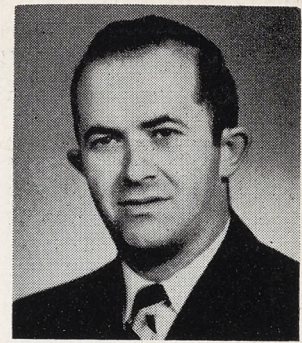
