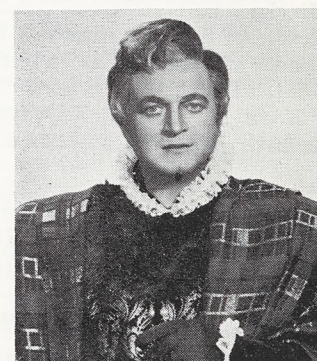

MEN'S CLUB INAUGURATES ANNUAL YOUTH CONCERT AWARD

Sunday, March 6th at 8:30 P.M.

The Men's Club of our Synagogue will inaugurate its first Annual Youth Concert Award with Itzhak Perlman, young Israeli born violinist, in his first New York recital on Sunday evening, March 6, 1966 at 8:30 P.M. at the West Side Institutional Synagogue. The proceeds of this event will be for our neighboring worthy Yeshiva, the Manhattan Day School, and for our own Synagogue.

The Men's Club has created a fund for the purpose of presenting a concert and citation as an award to a young instrumental artist who has achieved national recognition in the field of music.

Itzhak Perlman has appeared with the New York Philharmonic, Detroit and Washington Symphony Orchestras. In 1964 he won the Leventritt Award. Many will remember this award at which the violin he used, a Guagnerius valued at \$15,000, was stolen. Prior to winning the Leventritt Award, Itzhak Perlman played extensively in Israel and throughout the United States and Canada. As the winner of a contest in Israel he gained several appearances with the Ed Sullivan T.V. Show.
