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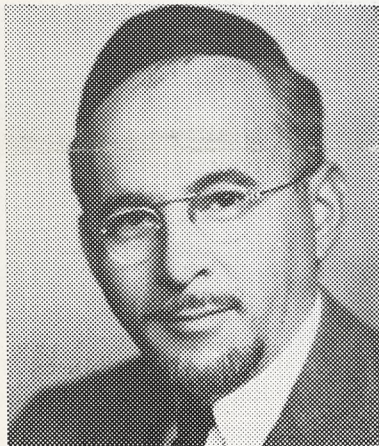

He is President of the Hebrew Home for the Aged in Riverdale where he has been active for the past twenty-five years. He is also President of the Yeshiva Rabbi Israel Salanter in the Bronx. Other pet projects of his are the children's Hebrew publication, "Olam Chodosh," of which he is President and Publisher, and the B'nai Brith's activities.

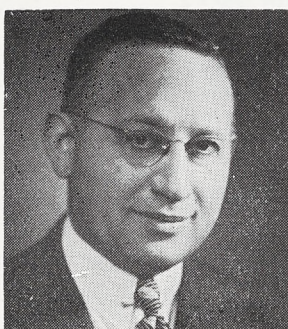
