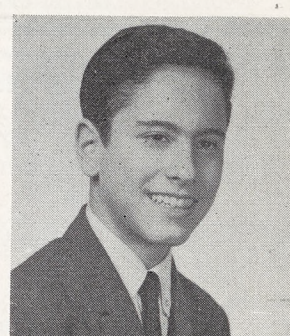

Chometz After Passover

Any chometz or chometz product in the possession of a Jew during Passover is considered "chometz sheavar alav ha-Pesach" — prohibited products preserved during Passover. We are not permitted to derive any benefit from such products nor may they be eaten. At the conclusion of Passover, one should not use any Jewish baked products until we are certain that the products have been freshly baked.

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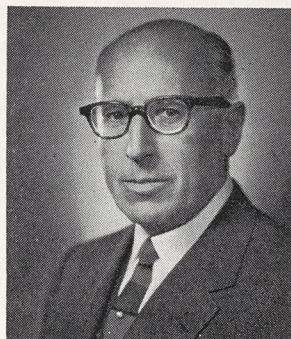
