### Holy Days Notes

#### ERUV TAVSHILIN

It is not permissible to cook or prepare food on one day of Yom Tov for the next day or for the Sabbath. The "Eruv Tavshilin" set aside prior to the Festival, enables the housewife to cook on Friday for the Sabbath. Inasmuch as this year Rosh Hashana will be on Thursday and Friday, the ceremony of Eruv Tavshilin should be performed on Wednesday, Erev Yom Tov.

Challah (bread) and some cooked food are placed on a plate. The master of the house lifts the plate and recites the following: "Boruch ataw a-do elo-kenu melech ha'olam asher kidshanu b'mitzvo-sav v'tzi-va-nu al mitzvahs e-ruv... By virtue of this Eruv, be it permitted to us to bake, cook, keep food warm, light the candles, and do all that is necessary on the Festival for the Sabbath."

On Saturday afternoon one partakes of this food.

#### ROSH HASHANA EVE

As with every Festival, Kiddush is recited over the wine and Shehecheyanu is added. On the second night, a new fruit which has not yet been eaten in its season is placed on the table for the Shehecheyanu of the Kiddush which embraces also the fruit. It is customary to dip the Hamotzi in honey to denote a sweet year.

#### TASHLICH

Tashlich, a deeply symbolic tradition, takes place on the first day of Rosh Hashana when we go to a body of water and resolve to free ourselves of our sins.
