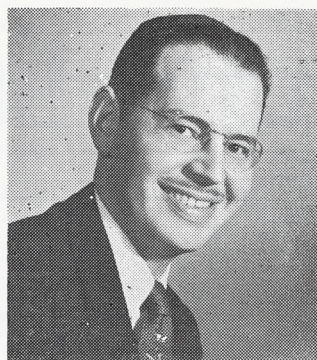
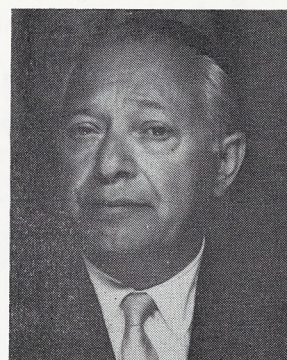
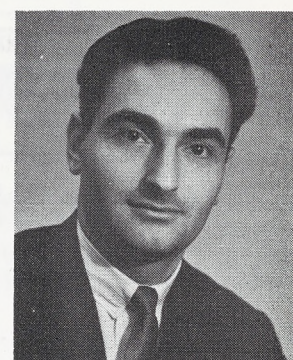
Dr. and Mrs. Weiss will tender a Kiddush to the entire Congregation following the Service.
