Martina Arroyo

Martina Arroyo, who sings the role of Leonora at our Metropolitan Opera Benefit on Saturday night, February 4th, 1967, is an artist who has portrayed many other great operatic roles from the stages of La Scala, Covent Garden and the Vienna State Opera, and from the concert halls of Salzburg, Berlin, Rome, Stockholm and Brahmsaal in Vienna.

Although Arroyo's great artistry was known in the concert and recital fields since 1958, it was not until February 1965 when she was called on by the Metropolitan Opera to substitute in the title role of "Aida" that she was accorded phenomenal critical and public acclaim. As a result of this triumph the Metropolitan Opera immediately offered her a contract.

GOOD NEWS FOR OUR GIRLS AND BOYS (8-13)**Oneg Saturday, November 12th**

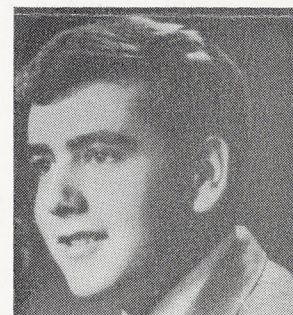
