OPERA COMMITTEE SPURS DRIVE FOR TICKET SALES

1,160 Have to be Sold

Only half of the expected gross sales has been made to date for the **WSIS BENEFIT of IL TROVATORE** at the new **METROPOLITAN OPERA HOUSE**, Saturday night, February 4th, 1967.

With 70% of the house sold out, there still remain 1,160 unsold seats, ranging in price from \$25 to \$40; seven \$200 boxes seating 8 and one \$300 box seating 8. Many who ordered the low priced seats. When informed that those were unavailable, cooperated by purchasing higher priced ones.

The following statement was issued by our hard working Opera Committee:

"Any relaxing of sales by the members and friends of the WSIS would be disastrous. Based on previous sold-out performances, the remaining half of the 1160 seats must be sold by WSIS members if we are to realize a sold-out opera performance. The Board of Trustee members are spearheading this drive. They have pledged that each member of the Board sell at least \$250 worth of tickets.

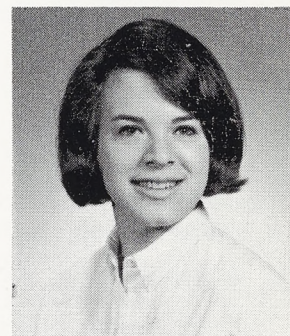
