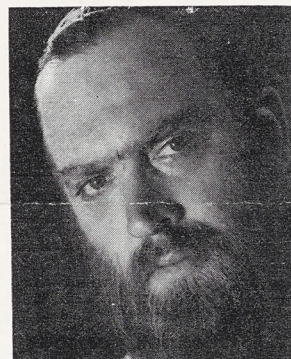
## PROMINENT PSYCHIATRIST AT OUR PUBLIC LECTURE TUESDAY NIGHT, APRIL 11th at 8:15

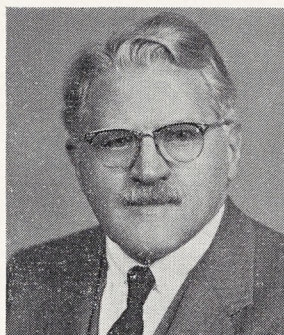

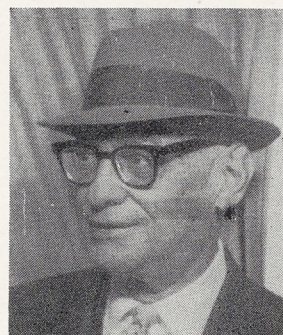

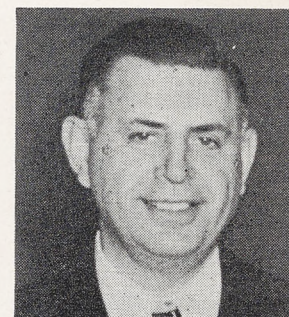

Rabbi Pekier will be available to attend to the sale of chometz during the hours of daily services. For those who cannot come personally to the Synagogue the attached coupon may be used.
