OF SYNAGOGUES**

After years in the making the first World Conference of Ashkenazi and Sephardi Synagogues will be held in the Holy City of Jerusalem the week of January 8th. For the first time the representative forces of traditional Synagogues will come together in world convocation. Some of the foremost spiritual and lay leaders will participate in this unprecedented array of representatives from Jewish communities from the four corners of the earth. It goes without saying that the program of the Conference will be lastingly rewarding intellectually and spiritually.

Under the aegis of the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations of America, several group tours at nominal rates have been scheduled beginning with December 26th and costing as little as \$525 round trip.

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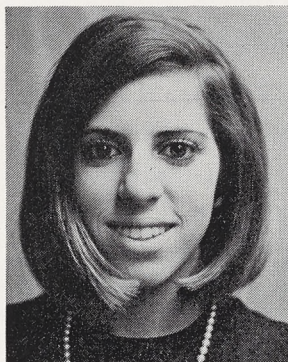
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GETTING PERSONAL
