ETHICS OF THE FATHERS*Comments by**Rabbi Herbert S. Goldstein***Chapter I, Mishna 3**

Antigonos of Socho received the tradition from SIMON THE JUST. He used to say, "Be not like servants who minister to their master upon the conditions of receiving a reward . . . LET THE FEAR OF HEAVEN BE UPON YOU." What has the Fear of Heaven to do with voluntary enlistment. This is a very important exhortation. We are bidden here to remember that doing something without receiving reward, doing something voluntarily is a very high type of service — namely, perform your voluntary service as if you are getting paid for it. Let the Fear of Heaven Be Upon You. Do not say, Oh, it is raining, I will go to the Synagogue meeting some other time or begin to pray tomorrow. This reminds me of the Mexican saying of Manyana — Tomorrow. The Tomorrow people live in the City of BY AND BY in the HOUSE OF NEVER.
