FESTIVAL NOTES**ROSH HASHANAH EVE**

As with every Festival, Kiddush is recited over the wine and Shehecheyanu is added. On the second night, a new fruit which has not yet been eaten in its season is placed on the table for the Shehecheyanu of the Kiddush which embraces also the fruit. It is customary to dip the Hamotzi in honey to denote a sweet year.

TASHLICH

Tashlich, a deeply symbolic tradition, takes place on the first day of Rosh Hashanah when we go to a body of water and resolve to free ourselves of our sins.

MUSSAF SERVICE

The Rosh Hashanah Mussaf Service is by far the longest Amidah in the Prayer Book. In the repetition of the Amidah by the Cantor, the sounding of the Shofar is repeated following the recitation of a series of Biblical quotations relating to: Malachius—G-d's sovereignty over all the world; Zichronos — G-d as the supreme Judge; Shofros — the sounding of the Shofar emphasizing our faith.

Mr. Nash Aussenberg, our neighbor, will again sound the shofar.

TZOM GEDALIAH

The Day after Rosh Hashanah is a Fast Day in memory of Gedaliah ben Achikam who was appointed Jewish Governor of Israel by Nebuchadnezzar after he destroyed the First Temple. Gedaliah was assassinated by his opponents and as a result all Jewish hope for self-government ended for a period of seventy years — the Babylonian Exile.

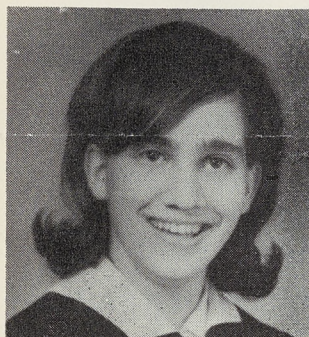
OPEN MEETING TO BE HELD MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 16th
