On the eve of Rabbi Reichel's twenty-fifth anniversary of his ordination at Yeshiva University, the Yeshiva University Press has just published Rabbi Reichel's book, *ISAAC HALEVY (1847-1914): Spokesman and Historian of Jewish Tradition*. This is a biography of an outstanding talmudist, scholar, and communal leader who made an indelible imprint upon modern Orthodox Jewish history.

Dr. Samuel Belkin, President of Yeshiva University has written in his Foreword to this volume: "Halevy not only wrote history but also pioneered in the making of Jewish history in his contemporary religious environment. This unknown phase of Halevy's life is exceptionally well presented by the author, using published and unpublished correspondence which appear in this volume. It therefore affords me great satisfaction to congratulate Rabbi Reichel for 'resurrecting' a great Jewish scholar who almost became the 'forgotten man.'"

This work resuscitates some interesting pages in the dynamic development of Orthodoxy at the turn of the last century. The Holy Land's first Chief Rabbi Abraham I. Kook, the renowned Talmudist Rabbi Haim Soloveichik, the historian Zev Jawitz, and the communal leader Jacob Rosenheim were among the many outstanding Jewish personalities of yesteryears who were in frequent contact with Halevy. His role in such institutions as the *Juedisch-Literarische Gesellschaft* and in the launching of the Agudath Israel movement are also brought to light in this book.
