The Four Species

In addition to the commandment of the Succah, the Torah commands us, "And you shall take on the first day the fruits of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and boughs of thick trees and willows of the brook and you shall rejoice before your G-d seven days" Leviticus XXIII:40. The fruit of the goodly tree is the *esrog*; the branch of the palm tree is the *lulav*; boughs of thick trees are the myrtle or *hadasim*; and the branches of the willow are the *aravose*.

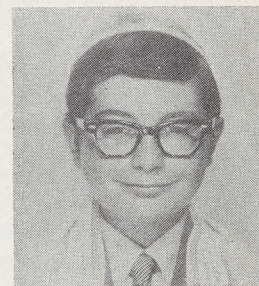
