WSIS OPERA BENEFIT OF LA TRAVIATA CITY OPERA, SATURDAY NITE, MARCH 4 AT LINCOLN CENTER

Of the many opera productions by the City Opera, LA TRAVIATA has received some of the finest press of the operas produced in many years.

When the City Opera moved from its 55th Street quarters to the State Theatre, many were fearful that it would be overshadowed by the Met. Time has proven otherwise. Thus Julius Rudel, Director of the City Opera and now also Artistic Director of the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C., created a sensation when he presented a new production of La Traviata in competition with the Met's new production just a week apart. Despite the greater financial resources of the Met, lo and behold the City Opera mounted a production that won critical acclaim over the one produced by the Metropolitan Opera. This was the last time both houses have given a new production of the same opera the same season.

The City Opera started a new trend in opera production to fuse good acting with great singing. Opera's music drama. La Traviata is great drama based on the play "LA DAME AUX CAMILLES" by Alexandre Dumas, and the music by Giuseppe Verdi. That is the reason LA TRAVIATA is one of the two top box office draws.

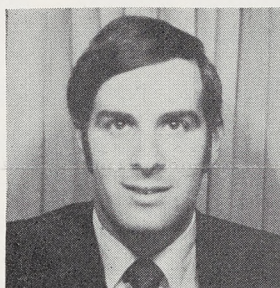
MEN'S CLUB NOTES**MEETINGS OCTOBER 18 AND NOVEMBER 1**

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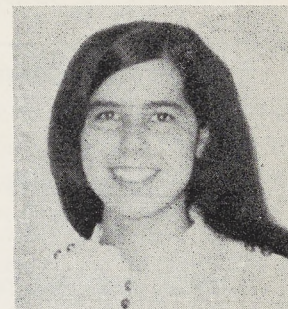
