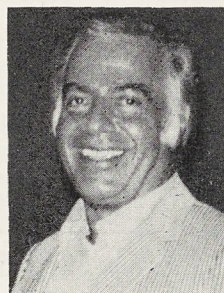

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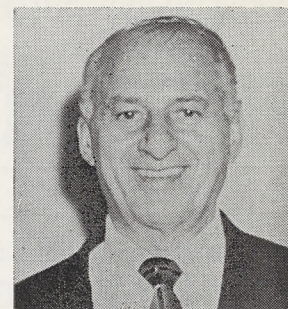
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MEN'S CLUB NOTES**MEETING SUNDAY, OCTOBER 28**

On Wednesday eve, October 10, we usher in the Festival of Tabernacles. Following the solemn High Holidays, it is in contrast a time of joyous celebration. The keynote of its observance is as expressed in the phrase "Vesamachta Bechagecha."

Breakfast in the Succah will be available following each of the weekday morning services.

Hoshana Rabbah — Wed., Oct. 17

The fifth day of Chol Hamoed is called Hoshana Rabbah. It is on this day that the decrees of Yom Kippur are sealed and the fate prescribed therein for each individual takes effect. Seven circuits are made this day with the four species, while chanting the Hoshana prayers.

It is a custom to read portions of the sacred works on the night of Hoshana Rabbah.

CHILDREN ESPECIALLY INVITED TO SIMCHAS TORAH SERVICES

**Thursday Eve., Oct. 18
and Friday Morning**

The children, who are always welcome in our Synagogue, are our special guests on this night. They will receive special Simchas Torah flags which they will carry during the *hakafos* (Torah processions). They will also be presented with sweets with the compliments of our Women's League.

Eruv Tavshilin

It is not permissible to cook or prepare food on one day of Yom Tov for the next or for the Sabbath. The "Eruv Tavshilin" set aside prior to the Festival, enables the housewife to cook on Friday for the Sabbath. Inasmuch as this year the Festivals will be on Thursday and Friday, the ceremony of Eruv Tavshilin should be performed on Wednesday, Erev Yom Tov.

Challah (bread) and some cooked food are placed on a plate. The head of the house lifts the plate and recites the following: "Boruch ataw a-do . . . elo-kenu melech ha'olam asher kid-shanu b'mitzvo-sav v'tzi-va-nu al mitzvas Eruv . . . By virtue of this Eruv, be it permitted to us to bake, cook, keep food warm, light the candles, and to do all that is necessary on the Festival for the Sabbath." On Saturday afternoon one partakes of this food.
