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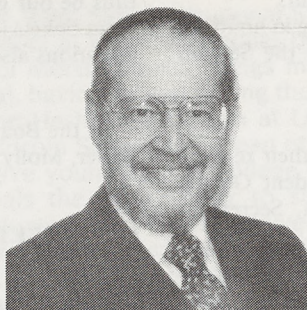

RABBI MORDUCHOWITZ ELECTED RABBI; RABBI REICHEL ELECTED RABBI EMERITUS INAUGURAL SERMON ON FEBRUARY 1

At a well-attended membership meeting on Monday evening, December 23rd, Rabbi Moshe M. Morduchowitz was elected as the third spiritual leader in the history of the WSIS. He succeeds Rabbi O. Asher Reichel who was elected Rabbi Emeritus for life in recognition of his uninterrupted 38 years of dedicated service to our congregation and community.

Rabbi Morduchowitz will deliver the inaugural sermon on February 1st. A festive kiddush will follow the service.

Rabbi Morduchowitz is the dean and founder of the Yeshiva of the West Side. He is a professor at C.U.N.Y. and at Touro College. He was acting Senior Rabbi of Lincoln Square Synagogue in 1983-84. Rabbi Morduchowitz is a graduate of Yeshiva College and was ordained at R.I.E.T.S. where he served as an assistant to Rabbi Joseph B. Soloveitchik. He did his graduate work at Harvard University in medieval history.

The Rabbi is married to the former Elke Epstein. They have two daughters 8 and 5, and a one-year-old son.

Rabbi Morduchowitz intends to introduce study classes into every area of synagogue life. The following is a listing of the classes he will be launching:

- A *Daf Yomi* (daily Talmud folio) class on Saturday 45 minutes before Minchah and on Sunday after Shacharis.
- Tuesday after Shacharis a Talmud class in *Taanit*.
- For beginners commencing Tuesday evening, February 4th, in conjunction with the Rabbi's Yeshiva — at 7:00 a Bible class on the Portion of the Week and at 8:30 a class on "To Pray As A Jew."

Rabbi Morduchowitz is very optimistic about bringing new members into our Congregation enabling the WSIS to continue to be a major force in the Jewish world as it was under Rabbi Herbert S. Goldstein z"l and Rabbi Reichel.

RABBI REICHEL TO BE HONORED BY M.D.S.

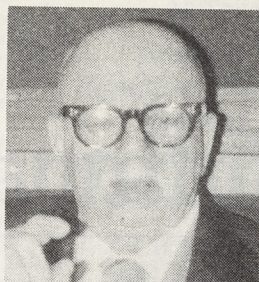
